Safer Internet Day ~ Tuesday 5th Feb

As part of Safer internet Day we will be looking at online safety in school next week. Almost all our children have access to the internet whether through computers, tablets, phones, x-box or other games consoles and we will be emphasizing the importance of not sharing personal information online or talking to anybody they or their parents don't know. We will also remind the children that the majority of social media including Facebook, WhatsApp, Instagram and SnapChat should only be used by children over 13 years.

This is partly because they may not be mature enough to ensure that they have a full understanding of the impact of their posts but more importantly it is to protect them from the unsuitable and distressing images which they may be able to access through these apps. Unfortunately we continue to see serious incidents related to internet safety in the news and I am sure you will have heard or read about the impact that posts/photos available through sites such as these are having on young and vulnerable people.

We have added a useful link to the NSPCC 'Net Aware' site on our school website, under the parents section— online safety. The page it links to gives guidance on the popular apps and games children use including fortnite. It also emphasizes that having open, regular conversations with your child will enable you to really understand and explore the online world together, helping you to keep them safe online.
